Longcroft School and Sixth Form School Shoes Guidance 2023-24



Our uniform provides an opportunity for our young people to demonstrate pride in their school community and their appearance. It is important that every young person in our community feels included and that our collective focus is on the business of learning. Therefore, we aim to ensure that not only are pupils dressed appropriately for a diverse and engaging curriculum, but also that they are freed so far as possible from the social pressures that fashion and material items can bring.

Footwear appropriate for school at Longcroft includes plain shoes (no decoration), professional, black, low-heeled, full leather with a plain black sole and stitching. Trainers (including black trainers), plimsolls or a converse style are **not permitted** — as they are fashion items or do not appropriately protect the feet. Plain black, low heeled boots can be worn under trousers only. UGG-style boots are considered a fashion item and **should not be worn**.
