

Catch-up premium: coronavirus (COVID-19) Statement

Context

The scope of the Covid-19 closure affected pupils across all year groups, regardless of their individual characteristics, so a significant portion of the actions taken to address the impact of Covid 19 is directed to increasing access to teaching for all pupils, especially in English and Mathematics. This involves a 25% increase of teaching time in English and Mathematics at all levels, in addition to access to the core curriculum, and an increase of 25% to A Level. We have extended the school day to ensure this does not narrow the curriculum.

2020 - 2021 Catch-up premium: coronavirus (COVID-19) - Expenditure

The Catch-Up premium: coronavirus (COVID-19) funding will be used in the following ways:

- To provide all pupils in Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4 with 1 hour per week additional time in core subjects (English and Maths) to identify and address gaps in learning that have emerged when pupils have been unable to attend school during lockdowns and periods of isolation.
- To increase time allocation for all sixth form subjects by one hour in Year 12 and 13.
